Over 8 months and not over 12 months Born on or between 01/11/24 and 28/02/25 Class 1402 BULL

Over 12 months and not over 16 months Born on or between 01/07/24 and 31/10/24 Class 1403 BULL

Over 16 months and not over 20 months Born on or between 01/03/24 and 30/06/24 Class 1404 BULL

Over 20 months and not over 24 months - Born on or between 01/11/23 and 28/02/24 Class 1405 BULL

Over 2 years - Born before 01/11/23

Class 1406 HEIFER

Over 8 months and not over 12 months - Born on or between 01/11/24 and 28/02/25 Class 1407 HEIFER

Over 12 months and not over 16 months - Born on or between 01/07/23 and 31/10/24 Class 1408 HEIFER

Over 16 months and not over 20 months - Born on or between 01/03/23 and 30/06/24 Class 1409 HEIFER

Over 20 months and not over 24 months - Born on or between 01/11/23 and 28/02/23 Class 1410 COW

Over 2 years and not over 2% years - Born on or between 01/05/23 and 31/04/23

Class 1411 COW

Over 2½ years - Born before 01/05/23

Class 1412 PAIR; BULL & HEIFER

Owned by exhibitor, not over 24 months - Born on or after 01/11/23

Class 1413 PAIR HEIFERS

Owned by exhibitor, not over 24 months - Born on or after 01/11/23

Class 1414 GROUP OF THREE

Owned by exhibitor, both sexes to be represented.







REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS

TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH GENERAL REGULATIONS

- A. All exhibitors must wear Breed attire.
- B. Exhibitors are requested to display stock on: SATURDAY 1st November 2025
- C. Registered names, number and tattoo marks must be stated on entry
- D. Combustion engines cannot be used in cattle pavilion.
- E. NO SMOKING IN PAVILIONS.
- F. All cattle must have N.L.I.S. identification tags.
- G. If staying overnight, membership must be purchased with entries.

BEEF

- H. Competition in this section is restricted to animals which are registered as "Adults" or in the "Calf Register" of their respective Herd Book Societies of Australasia.
- I. All cattle must be adequately secured with neck strap & halter.
- J. All bulls over 12 months must be rung and led by nose & halter.
- K. All females must be led by a halter & nose clip at all times.
- L. All cattle must be in a presentable condition.
- M. All beef cattle to be tested pestivirus negative, paperwork to be sent in with entries
- N. The Society will add extra classes in this section if necessary.
- O. JOHNE'S DISEASE: Cattle Health Status declaration must be completed and photocopy submitted with show entries. Original must be produced on demand at our Show.
- P. Beef Cattle will be housed in Pavilions which are available evening prior to showing of cattle.
- Q. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: "For Sale" signs may be placed above exhibits in the Pavilion, providing notice is given in writing to the Society Secretary prior to the Show, and exhibitors will notify their own Agents, if they so desire.

DAIRY

- R. Any animal owned in partnership or syndicate, can only be exhibited by that partnership or syndicate, and not by any one individual member of that partnership or syndicate.
- S. Genetic Recovery & Appendix listed cattle are eligible to compete, but this must be clearly stated with entry.
- T. Competition is restricted to animals which are registered in the Herd Book or Calf Register (or equivalent) of the respective Cattle Society.
- U. All exhibits must be bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
- V. If any exhibit, after winning her class, is not paraded for the championship and/or reserve award, the second placegetter from the same class becomes eligible to compete for these awards.
